Please check in before beginning to set up at the check in table by the front entry or bus lane entry.
Set up times are on Friday, November 8, 2024 from 6 pm-8 pm (no early arrivals please as we will be preparing for set up) or Saturday, November 9, 2024 from 6:30am-8:30am.
Ironmen Bands volunteers will be available to help with move-in and move-out. Carts are for our volunteers to use to assist you. Due to limited carts, there may be a wait. Volunteers are for assisting you in loading/unloading the cart at your booth and vehicle only. Please make sure all items are boxed up and ready to load onto the cart before asking for assistance. Tips to support the band are appreciated, but not required!
Tables are not provided, but can be rented for $\$ 10$ each. Chair(s) are included with your booth and available upon request.
You MUST keep all driveways, ramps, and fire lanes open AT ALL TIMES. After unloading, please park all vendor vehicles at the far end of the parking lot to allow convenient parking for our customers.
All crafters and vendors must stay within their allotted and marked space(s). If more space is needed, please sign up for additional booth space.
Registrants are responsible for cleaning up their own space. Early teardown is not permitted and may forfeit registrants ability to participate in following year.
Lunch/snack menus and ordering information will be in your packet at check in. Delivery to your booth is available.
